What is it?

A volunteer friend - or family - is for anyone with a refugee background, whether you have just arrived in Denmark or have been here for some time. They can be someone to spend time with and practice your Danish language skills. Your volunteer friend will often have knowledge, experience and social networks that can be useful to you. Among other things, they can explain letters from the authorities, support you in your job search or help you explore opportunities in your local community, like sports clubs. It is also someone you can "hygge" with.

Who are the volunteers?

The volunteers are ordinary people in your local community who want to support you – and maybe your family – in creating a good life while you are in Denmark. They do not work for the municipality or other authorities, and they do not receive money for their time. They are volunteers because they want to help others and find it interesting to meet new people and learn more about you and your background.
